Rec Center Rules

1. All participants must show their Resident Pass to the Recreation Specialist as well as sign-in for the appropriate program.
2. The gymnasium has a capacity of 30 participants per court. Usage is on a first come first serve basis. Participants will not be permitted entrance once capacity has been met.
3. Proper athletic attire must be worn at all times. This includes closed toed athletic shoes, shirts, and athletic shorts or pants.
4. No food or gum allowed in the gymnasium. Drinks with sealed caps are permitted. Glass bottles and soda cans are not permitted.
5. Appropriate language is expected at all times.
6. No horseplay/roughhousing.
7. There is zero-tolerance for physical altercations, threatening or harassing behavior, bullying, theft, and the use of illicit or illegal substances including alcohol.
8. No dunking, hanging on the rim, climbing nets, etc.
9. No punting/kicking basketballs.
10. No climbing the bleachers.
11. Audible devices are limited to personal use with headphones. Please no external speakers, radios, stereos, etc.
12. Equipment is available to borrow from the Rec Center. All equipment must be signed out and returned the same day in the same condition. If failure to return equipment, a replacement fee will be assessed.
13. Full court basketball games are not permitted during scheduled Open Gym.

Disciplinary Process

1. Verbal Warning.
2. Written Warning. Must be signed by the participant and a parent/guardian before reentry.
3. Meeting between Parent/Guardian and child with the Rec Center Manager to assess behavior and discuss expectations.
4. Suspension of 1-3 days if warranted, depending on seriousness of infractions.
 - *Continued violations may result in a 1-3 month suspension.
 - * Suspensions may be extended up to 6 months due to severity and regularity of infractions.
 - *The violation of Rule #7 will result in an immediate suspension of 1-3 days.*
 - * All violations will be reviewed by the Disciplinary Committee to determine if further suspension is warranted.*
 - *Security cameras may be reviewed and interviews with other participants may occur.*
 - *All suspended participants must set up a meeting to speak with the Rec Center Manager before reentry.*

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and understand the South Kingstown Recreation Center Rules for usage of the facility. I understand that failure to adhere to the Rec Center policies may lead to disciplinary actions, including but not limited to suspension of all Rec Center programs and events.
