Trash Disposal Guidelines	
<h3>Household Refuse</h3>	<h3>Tires</h3>
 <p>\$1.80/Tag</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each refuse bag requires an adhesive strap “tag” around the bag neck prior to disposal; both ends of tag must be visible Tags are \$1.80 each and are sold in lots of 5. Tags may be purchased at the RHRTS or either Town Hall Bag volume is limited to 33 Gallons. Bag weight is limited to 35 Lbs. Refuse bags exceeding volume or weight will require an additional tag 	 <p>\$2.89/Tire</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is a \$2.89 fee for each tire 18” in diameter or less Tires over 18” will be charged \$5.79 for each tire. Additional \$5.00 charge for removal of rims.
<h3>Bulky Items</h3>	<h3>Appliances</h3>
 <p>6¢/Lb</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A fee of 6¢/pound (\$5.00 minimum) will be charged for bulky items such as furniture, demolition or construction material (4’ length maximum), etc. Single bulky items weighing 35 lbs or less may be disposed of with a “tag” Mattress and Box Springs will be assessed a flat charge of \$23.15 per piece. 	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Freon Appliance: A flat fee of \$17.36 will be charged for the disposal of <u>each</u> Freon Appliance (this includes refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.) Non-Freon Appliance: A flat fee of \$5.79 will be charged for the disposal of <u>each</u> Non-Freon appliance.
Yard Waste Disposal Guidelines	
<h3>Leaves and Grass</h3>	<h3>Yard Waste and Brush</h3>
 <p>\$1.22/Tag</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Yard Waste Tags may be purchased to dispose of leaves and grass clippings in brown paper yard waste bags. Individual Yard Waste Tags may be purchased at the RHRTS or Town Hall for \$1.22. Leaves and grass clippings will not be accepted in plastic bags 	 <p>3.5¢/Lb</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Large brush, bulk quantities of leaves, tree limbs and trunks less than 6” in diameter may be discharged at a rate of 3.5¢/pound (\$5.00 minimum) No branches over 6” in diameter are allowed Ask the RHRTS attendant for information on how to weigh your material and make payment

Recycling Guidelines (Separate into Two Categories)

Green Bin Recycling



Mixed Paper

- Writing, Computer, and Shredded Paper
- Junk Mail, Envelopes, Magazines, Catalogs
- Phone Books, Paperback Books



Newspaper

- All Newspapers, Ads and Inserts
- Bundled or Bagged in Paper
- Do Not Put in Plastic Bags



Corrugated Cardboard

- Old Corrugated Cardboard (wavy corrugation between layers), Brown Paper Bags
- Remove Staples, Liners and Packaging; Empty, Breakdown and Flatten Boxes
- Less than 3 Feet Long or Wide



Thin Cardboard

- Shoe Boxes, Cereal Boxes, Gift Boxes
- Egg Cartons
- No Boxes with Silver or Foil Coatings
- No Detergent Boxes
- No Soda or Beer Packaging

Blue Bin Recycling



Plastics

- #1 and #2 Plastic Jugs and Bottles
- Rinse Clean Prior to Disposal



Drink Cartons

- Milk, Juice, Cream Cartons
- Juice Boxes
- Rinse Clean



Metal and Aluminum Cans

- Vegetable, Soda, Coffee Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans, Toasters, Irons, Wire Hangers
- Clean Foil and Pie Plates
- Scrap Metal Less than 3 ft Long and 35 Lbs
- Rinse Cans



Glass

- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Rinse
- No Broken Glass, Dishes, Glass Windows, Pyrex, Crystal
- No Light Bulbs, Mirrors

Miscellaneous



- Dispose of electronic waste and televisions for free at the RHRTS.
- Ask the RHRTS attendant to direct you to the “pods” drop-off area



- Recycle your clean, dry plastic bags in the designated bins in the Residential Recycling Area



- Deposit textbooks, dictionaries, encyclopedias, hard and soft cover books in the appropriate section of the RHRTS Book Shed.
- Help yourself to other books!



- Deposit Residential Automotive Waste Motor Oil, Lawn Mower Waste Motor Oil and Oil Filters in the RHRTS “Oil Igloo”
- Limited to five gallons per trip; Use caution - do not spill oil



- Contact the RI Resource Recovery (RIRRC) at 942-1430 for information on the disposal of hazardous waste such as oil-based paint, paint thinners, household solvents, chemical cleansers, pesticides, gasoline, kerosene, anti-freeze. etc.



- The RHRTS will **not** accept household hazardous waste, liquids, human or animal remains, pathological waste, hot coals or ash, farm, auto or large equipment, and other items as deemed inappropriate by the Town.
