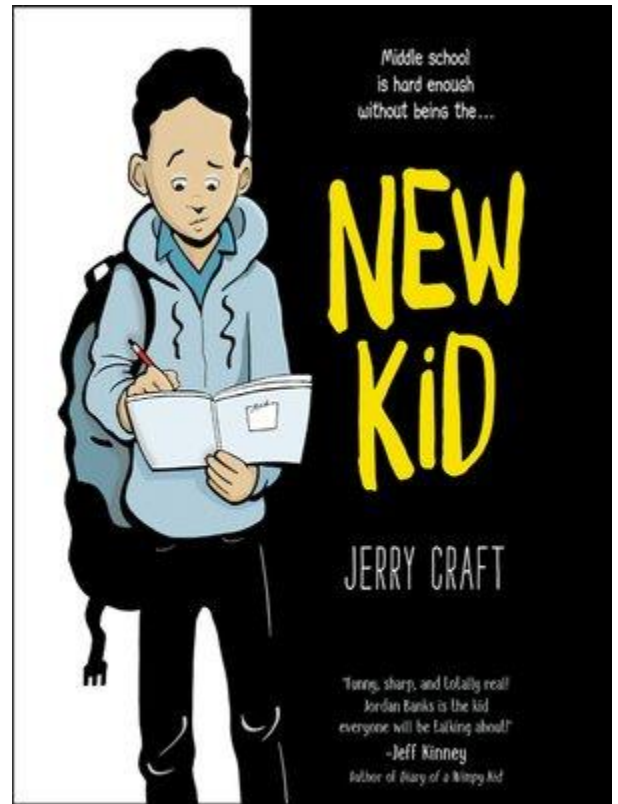


The New Kid by Jerry Craft
