**Full Outdoor Water Ban for Narragansett and South Kingstown
(Veolia Rhode Island and Town) Water Customers**

In response to recent dry conditions and heavy consumer demand, Veolia Rhode Island, and the Towns of South Kingstown and Narragansett have announced a ban on **all** outdoor water use for the following water system customers:

- Veolia Rhode Island water system customers
- Town of South Kingstown South Shore and Middlebridge water system customers
- Town of Narragansett - Veolia Rhode Island supply area water system customers (North Kingstown supply area customers remain on odd/even restriction)

Please note that these restrictions do not affect Kingston Water District customers.

**Effective immediately, a mandatory ban is in effect on all outdoor water use
until further notice.**

This watering ban is being enacted to ensure sufficient fire protection and supply to meet customer needs. In addition, water customers are encouraged to use water wisely.
