South Kingstown Police Department Offers “Ship to Station” Service *Residents may ship packages to the police station to deter “porch pirates”*

The South Kingstown Police Department today announced that South Kingstown residents can ship their packages directly to the South Kingstown Police Station to prevent theft this holiday season.

“More Americans are shopping online than ever before and as a result, package theft and crimes of opportunity have increased in otherwise safe communities,” said Matthew C. Moynihan, Chief of Police. “With holiday shopping upon us, we want to deter ‘porch pirates’ in South Kingstown and hope that residents will use ‘Ship to Station.’ We will also focus additional patrols in residential areas and continue to encourage residents to ‘see something say something’ as we work together to keep our neighborhoods safe.”

To ship your package to the South Kingstown Police Station please follow these 3 steps:

1. When making online purchases, use this address:

Attn: Ship to Station

2. Forward your confirmation or send an email to shiptostation@skpd.org so we can expect to see the package and we can notify you when the package arrives.
3. Bring a photo ID, copy of your email or delivery confirmation when coming to pick up your package. The name on the ID must match the name on the package.

The South Kingstown Police Department is not responsible for damaged or undelivered packages. Please do not use Ship to Station for packages that require a signature, as they will not be accepted.

Residents are also encouraged to use our north parking lot as a safe e-commerce zone when in-person meetings with strangers are required to finalize online transactions. We encourage this practice year-round and have designated spots in the north parking lot for this purpose.
