## Construction Notice – Update 11.22.21

### Increase of activity in Transmission Right of Way

Dear Neighbors,

This notice is being sent as a courtesy to update you on the plan to upgrade the transmission assets along the 3302 transmission line. You may recall a previous notice regarding an increase in activity in the ROW. We wanted to update you of the proposed work in case you have any questions during the construction process.

The first construction activity will be vegetation clearing activities. This activity was slated to begin the week of September 20<sup>th</sup>. Due to emergency work and resource availability that schedule has been adjusted and now will begin the week of December 6<sup>th</sup>, with hours of operations from 7am to 4pm weekdays, again barring weather or emergency. You will see crews traveling through the Right of Way trimming trees, removing overgrowth and other various activities to prepare the area for the construction crews. The work will progress along the Right of Way with crews located in a given area anywhere from a few days to a few weeks. Crews may revisit the same location along the right of way several times during this time period.

Construction activities of the transmission line are expected to begin shortly after this vegetation management finishes and continue to an anticipated completion in late Spring 2022. The Right of Way work will be contained within National Grid's existing property. This work is part of an overall program designed to provide safe and reliable electricity for the region. As construction progresses, we will keep you updated. If you have any questions or would like further information, please feel free to contact me.
